John – Vice Commander - Their Mission is recreational boater safety with boater education classes at Longbridge fire department, presentations at HOAs, clubs, organizations and more, free boat safety inspections vessel and materials for your safety. Recently they received a grant which has allowed them to purchase 2 viper radio to communicate with Fire and Rescue.

A few requirements to remember:

- An emergency shutoff switch is required to be attached to boat operator on vessels more than 16' to 30'.
- Fire extinguishers on vessels must have a date stamp newer than 12 years old. Be sure to check the dates when buying a fire extinguisher.
- Jet ski operators must be at least 14 years old and have a boater safety certificate.
- Compacity for vessels including jet skis must include anyone in the vessel and being towed.

Questions for Speakers

There were good questions for John on Standoff rule, owner of vessel is responsible for damages, no matter who is driving, enforcement action by Auxiliary, Coast Guard and Wildlife.
